## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

This Company recognises the importance of maintaining our operations to ensure the Safety of and protecting the Environment. This Company recognises that effective management of our Environment makes good business sense and will be a fundamental and integral part of our business strategy. We are committed to considering the broader environmental impact of our operations, including the challenges posed by global warming and climate change.

To ensure we achieve these standards, procedures will be implemented to include the following:

- Being aware of how our activities impact the environment and seeking to minimise adverse effects by means of the best practices and available techniques, not entailing excessive cost, through a Policy of Quality, Health and Safety, and Environmental improvement in the workplace, control of pollution, and care for the local Environment.
  
- Complying with our legal responsibilities and responding proactively to future environmental legislation, particularly those addressing climate change and the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions.
  
- Complying with Network Rail Environmental Policies.
  
- Conserving the use of resources, particularly those that are scarce or non-renewable, including the following:
  - a. To avoid waste and encourage conservation, re-use, and recycling. e.g., Conservation and Waste disposal Management.
  - b. To preserve, restore, and enhance the built and natural heritage.
  - c. To encourage the sustainable use of land-based resources and certified timber and wood products.
  - d. To prevent air, land, and water pollution. e.g., toxic chemical sprays, motor exhaust, etc.
  
- Addressing climate change impacts:
  - a. Identifying opportunities to reduce energy consumption where feasible and promoting energy-efficient practices in our operations.
  - b. Being mindful of greenhouse gas emissions resulting from our activities and exploring practical ways to minimise them.

- Being sensitive to the Environmental concerns of our Clients and Community through which we operate and responding to them.
- Setting Environmental objectives to continually improve our Environmental performance and monitor the progress of achievement.
- Using Supplies and Practices with proper regard for the way we operate by disposing of waste materials as required by current legislation and to communicate this policy to all our Staff.
- Eliminating where possible but if this is not possible, reducing to as low as practicable our environmental aspects that have impacts, specifically minimising the environmental impact for the life cycle (including disposal) of plant, equipment, and other physical assets under the control of the organisation.
